

Information:

- MFSC will <u>NOT</u> be responsible for lost or stolen articles, for any loss, damages, or injury to horse, rider or spectator. You enter and ride at your own risk.
- SEI approved helmets MUST be worn by <u>ALL</u> minor participants. <u>NO Helmet waivers accepted.</u> All minors must have a signed waiver at the show office signed by a parent or legal guardian only. Riders must wear boots with heels.
- Separate Number per horse/rider combo must be displayed!
- Original Negative Coggins dated within last 12 mos. required to be given to office and put on file for season (as paper copy or \$5 fee to be printed by show office. Pre-Entry coggins sent=no fee)
- All out of state horses must be accompanied by health certificates dated within 30 days of the show and also have an original negative Coggins test within the previous 12 months with a copy left at office.
- Entries must be made two classes ahead.
- Show will be held drizzle or shine unless hazardous conditions/heavy rain exist then rain date set above. If questions, please call or watch fb Menomonee Falls Saddle Club FB Group for updates!!
- In case of discrepancies, the Show Committee decision is final.
- Absolutely NO running in or out of gate! This will result in a No Time for that class. This is for the safety of everyone. You may do a coutesy circle prior to run within area of arena before timers.
- All dogs must be leashed. No dogs permitted in horse arenas or holding areas.
- The Menomonee Falls Saddle Club Grounds will close about one hour after the last class. Porta-Potty on club grounds with hand sanitizer.
